Frequently Asked Questions

1. How can I live at the South Dakota Veterans Home?

Be a resident of South Dakota. Be an honorably discharged Veteran or the spouse or widow of such a Veteran. Be ambulatory and able to care for self and living area.

2. What does it cost to live there?

Single Veterans - 50% of gross income

Married Couples - 55% of combined gross income

Nursing Care - the fee is based on ability to pay and eligibility for Medicaid. Maximum fees, based on actual cost of care, are established annually, and your fees will not exceed that maximum.

3. What do the costs cover?

Room and 3 meals per day, medical care, laundry, medication, social services, activities, and pastoral care.

4. How do I get approved?

See your Veterans Service Officer in the county where you reside.
